President Garret Hultgren called the meeting to order at 10:03 A.M. with 15 members in attendance.

September 2011 Monthly Minutes

Minutes: The minutes of the July meeting were presented and approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jim Ferry reported the club's year-to-date income is \$2,741.08 with expenses of \$1,875.73. The checkbook balance is \$4,987.86 with \$00.00 in petty cash. The passbook savings now totals \$3,502.81. The treasurer's report was unanimously approved. The Horton Field lease was renewed at \$1100 for the next 12 months. Jim has logged 39 paid members which is 56 total when family members are included.

Safety Officer's Report: Joe Wilson was at work and unable to attend. He had no safety issues to report. Don Vagge related an incident where he was taking off the water in wind with choppy water conditions. The aircraft prematurely became airborne and nearly stalled. Be aware in windy conditions that your take-offs may be premature.

Old Business: Gene Burmeister noted that the Horton weather station phone number has been changed back to (970) 672-3331. He has declared the system up and running. On occasion, the phone may go offline for a day, but it will reset overnight. The system is getting a work out averaging around 130 calls logged per month.

New Business: Garret Hultgren was authorized to purchase a new wind sock for Horton Field. The estimated cost is \$55. He has a replacement for the Jax wind sock. Bill Dailey was authorized to purchase

more RoundUp spray to treat the weeds at Horton field. Thanks for the occasional spraying, Bill - it really makes a difference!

The next meeting will be Saturday, September 3rd, at Horton Field at 10:00 A.M. Come celebrate Bill Dailey's retirement!
