Minutes of the October 2017 Meeting

Date and Location: Saturday, October 7, 2017 at Horton field.

Call to Meeting: President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 11:04 AM on a Saturday morning with 11 members in attendance, including Safety Officer Joe Wilson, Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

Minutes: Secretary Dust sincerely apologized for miss-spelling "Davias" name in the September Minutes. The minutes of the September meeting were approved unanimously, with the correction noted.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ferry reported the club's current checkbook balance is \$4,039.56 and the savings balance is \$7,628.15. The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.
