Minutes of the January 2018 Meeting

Date and Location: Wednesday, January 2, 2019 at HobbyTown- Fort Collins.

Call to Order: President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 6:32 PM with 18 members in attendance, including Vice-President Durbin Seidel, Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

Minutes: The minutes of the November meeting were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ferry reported the club's current checkbook balance is \$1,313.34 and the savings balance is \$10,634.47. The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.

Safety Officer's Report: On behalf of Safety Officer Joe Wilson, President Craig requested that the membership refresh themselves with both the AMA and the Club's safety rules, take time to double check motors and motor mounts, and have a Happy New Year. President Craig then lead a discussion of mishaps, including the confession that this past year he had the rudder hinges fail on his Extra 260. Fred Damm described how "someone else's" fueled engine plane dangerously backed away from a plane restraint because of a pusher prop.

Old Business: President Craig took the opportunity to remind the membership that annual dues are due this month/January.

New Business: Secretary Dust reported that the FAA has automatically extended the expiration date for "Small UAS Registrations" from January 2019 to 12/12/2020 and encouraged everyone to download/print their new "Small UAS Certificate of Registration".

2. Following a brief discussion, the motion to add a "sale or trade" section to the club's webpage was approved unanimously.

3. Following discussion of the various options, the motion to purchase two new "4-ply" front tires for the riding mower was approved unanimously.

4. President Craig lead the discussion of the 2019 Budget with the membership and the motion to

accept the 2019 Budget of \$2820 passed unanimously.

Show and Tell: Charlie Greeb presented his E-Flite “Clipped-Winged Cub” foamy that features a 49 inch wingspan, 10-sized electric motor, and a unique main gear suspension. Charlie emphatically said that the plane is very fast and very aerobatic.

Meeting Adjourned at about 7:15 PM.
