Minutes of the May 2016 Meeting

Date and Location: Saturday, May 7, 2016 at the Horton Flying Field

Call to Meeting: President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM on a Saturday morning with 7 members in attendance, including Vice-President Durbin Seidel, Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

Minutes: The minutes of the March meeting were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Jim Ferry reported the club's current checkbook balance is \$5,360.81 and the savings balance is \$7,523.61. The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.

Safety Officer's Report: President Craig reported that Safety Officer Joe Wilson requests that those flying with 72 mHz radios should carefully ask everyone else flying if they are also flying with a 72 mHz before powering their transmitter(s).

Old Business: President Craig reported that the Club's new weather station can be accessed via Weather Underground webpage; however, Mr. Jeff Stolzenburg and Mr. Gene Burmeister are working on trying to also provide "call-in" functionality. President Craig further reported that the Club's new weather station cost about \$300 more than the initially expected \$350.

2. President Craig reported that LoveAir's fun-fly is scheduled for June 4th and the flier for the event will be distributed to the membership when it becomes available. The motion to offer assistance to LoveAir during the fun-fly was approved unanimously. The motion to move Rocky Mountain Modeleers' June Club meeting back one week to June 11th at 11 AM was approved unanimously.

New Business: President Craig thanked Mr. Doug Bland for doing an excellent job of mowing and weed-control, and reported that Doug will be reimbursed for expenses, including the purchase of a back-pack sprayer.

2. The membership discussed the request for the Club to do "a lunch demonstration" at the Swift Ponds facilities for Cub Scouts. Vice President Durbin was requested to get additional information.

3. President Craig reported that he and Mr. Garret Hultgren flew their Corsairs during the "Field Day" event at the Eyestone Elementary School in Wellington and thanked Mr. Jeff Stolzenburg and Secretary Dust for their assistance.

Show & Tell: Vice President Durbin presented his Dumas kit boat that he built and described its performance and operation.

Meeting Adjourned at approximately 11:25 AM.
