Minutes of the November 2016 Meeting

Date and Location: Wednesday, November 2, 2016 at Hobby Town (3500 S. College, Fort Collins)

Call to Meeting: President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 6:34 PM on a Wednesday evening with 12 members in attendance, including Vice-President Durbin Seidel, Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

Minutes: The minutes of the October meeting were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ferry reported the club's current checkbook balance is \$3,174.34 and the savings balance is \$7,524.75. The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.

Safety Officer's Report: On behalf of Safety Officer Wilson, President Craig reported that the Safety Officer reviewed this year's safety records and "saw nothing of serious concern ... well done"!

Old Business: None.

New Business: Fred Damm delivered flying equipment and airplanes donated to the Club by former long-time member Elliot Ray. The donated equipment and airplanes not claimed at the last meeting will be brought to the January meeting.

2. Secretary Dust described that the Club's web-page needs significant updating and that the Club may need to change the hosting service for the web-page. During the meeting, Garret Hultgren contacted/texted Lance Albanese and confirmed that his company can continue to host the Club's web-page. The motion to approve \$120 per year for hosting the Club's web-page was approved unanimously. Secretary Dust and Charlie Greeb volunteered to serve on the committee to update the Club's web-page, plus Vice-President Durbin tentatively volunteered Larry McClure for the committee.

Show-And-Tell: Charlie Greeb presented his new EFlite Timber, a bush-plane styled aircraft featuring a 61 inch wingspan, flaps, and shock-absorbing landing gear system. Charlie highly recommends this slow flying aircraft and described it as "an epitome of an old-fart's airplane."

Meeting Adjourned at approximately 6:56 PM.
