## Minutes of the April 2019 Meeting

**Date and Location:** Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at HobbyTown- Fort Collins.

**Call to Order:** President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM with 11 members, including Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the March meeting were approved unanimously. However, the Minutes

of the March meeting incorrectly reported that “Dave Swenson and Michael Keenan-Heart presented their Dynam Tiger Moths (50 inch wingspan) featuring their very impressive custom camouflage paint schemes.” It was actually Dave Swenson and Rich Samuelson that had presented their customized Tiger Moths.

**Treasurer’s Report:** Treasurer Ferry reported the club’s current checkbook balance is \$3213.39 and the savings balance is \$10,642.72. The treasurer’s report was approved unanimously.

**Old Business:** Secretary Dust reported that after getting the right front tire for the lawn mower mounted to the rim and inflated, he found that the valve now has a slow leak. Secretary Dust volunteered to purchase and install a new valve core.

**2. Secretary Dust** reported that the new “Trade-N-Sell” section to the club’s webpage is ready to be implemented and lead a brief discussion to refine the downloadable instruction sheet.

**New Business:** President Craig reported that a room at the fairgrounds has been reserved for May 18<sup>th</sup>, if the Club wanted to have a Swap-Meet. The motion to have a Swap Meet on May 18, 2019 did not pass; however, the membership expressed interest in having a Swap-Meet in March of 2020.
