FAA Remote ID rules boil down to 3.

- 1) Flying at a FRIA registered field then no further actions are necessary.
- 2) Flying away from a FRIA registered field requires a broadcast module associated with your FAA registration number.
- 3) Commercial flying requires registration and module per craft.
